Today begins the solemn celebration of Holy Week. This week is the most important week of our faith. This is the week that we commemorate the passion, death, and resurrection of the Lord. The week culminates with the celebrations on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil (Holy Saturday). I invite and encourage you to find a way to commemorate the significance of these days.
