He would like St. Mary's to have enough funds to sustain us for a year, in case some sort of crisis arises.

Fr. Rod felt the rectory in IAF is in need of several upgrades:

New carpet (stain resistant)

Curtains, sand down and paint the walls, new flooring in the kitchen, new furniture.

The goal is to provide a comfortable, inviting home for current and future priests.

All were in agreement the upgrades would be very beneficial.

Fr. Rod would shop and get samples, estimates and such.

Iowa Falls and Eldora would split the cost 55/45%.

Both topics: Funds and possible Rectory upgrades will be presented to Finance Council for further discussion.

Fr. Rod inquired on the committees of St. Mary, what we as members see for our goals of the parish. We discussed the many pluses St. Mary has and what we would like to see come back. Thanksgiving Dinner, Lasagna Supper, Stewardship (Fr. Rod will work with Cecilia). St. Mary is very strong in community, within the church and out. Communication, and giving.

We assigned roles for PC through the '22/23 year. Lorelei Lake-Chair Kim Brinkmeyer-Vice Chair Cecilia Penning-Secretary
