Dispensation: Remember that everyone is still dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday and Holy Day Mass until further notice. Please stay safe at home and do not come to Mass if you...

- Are sick, or have recently been sick, or have an underlying medical condition.
- Are frail due to advanced age.
- Are nervous about contracting COVID-19.
- Live with and/or care for someone sick, elderly, at-risk, or with COVID-19.
 Work at or regularly visit high-risk situations, where there are COVID-19 cases.

Even with Mass being offered in our parishes, the above-mentioned folks should stay home, either to protect themselves or others from contagion. For those at home, we will continue to live stream Mass from St. Mark. The link can be found on the linkage website: *www.FranklinHardinCatholic.org*

Per Archbishop Jackels' directives, we are asking those attending Mass to wear a mask, practice social distancing, and receive Holy Communion in the hand. However, if you do still wish to receive communion on the tongue, as this is a valid way of receiving communion, we ask that you go to the end of the communion line and receive last.

Until further notice, we will not have altar servers, Eucharistic ministers, greeters or gift bearers. Hymnals and books have been removed from the pews to minimize contact points. Unfortunately, we will not have singing at Mass until further notice. All items have been removed from the playroom.

Arrival: Plan to enter through the south or north door. Doors will be propped open and hand sanitizer will be available. Ushers will direct you to seating that is safely spaced. The parish hall door will be locked. We encourage everyone to refrain from entering the parish hall to reduce the need to sanitize the area. Should the main church/Chapel seating be filled, you will be directed to the north foyer.

Collection: If you bring your offering to Mass, please place it in the designated baskets at each entrance as you arrive or depart. There will not be a collection taken during Mass.

Communion: Fr. Kevin will give directions for Communion. Please maintain a distance of 6 feet (approximately 3 pews) while in line.

Bulletins: Printed bulletins will once again be available. Please take one from the table as you depart the church after Mass, or plan to read it online. Other faith

materials may be available as you leave. Please do not bring any of these booklets or materials into the church pews.
