Collecting items- In bulletin to start collecting gently used clothing, toys, small furniture, tools, kitchen utensils and similar items. We are excluding large appliances, soft furniture, and electronics. We have the right to refuse items. Times will be Thursday 29th 8 am to 5 pm, 30th 8 am to 5 pm, and 31st 8-12.

Set-up--Tuesday-August 27th and Wednesday-August 28th afternoons starting at 1 pm. If items are needed to be dropped off at another time, arrangements can be made. Starting July 20th after Saturday masses, items can be dropped off in Room 100 in the RE Center when committee member will be present.

Youth and adult volunteers are needed to help set-up, working sale, and clean-up. A sign-up sheet will be placed in Social Hall around August 1.

Sale-It is being proposed a brown grocery sack can be purchased for \$2.00 that can be filled with most clothing. Certain clothing items that are obviously worth more will have price on them.

Pricing items-As above some clothing will not have to be priced. Other items will be marked. How will be determined later.

Unsold items will go to Thrift Store in Iowa Falls or Good Will in Mason City.

Discussion was done regarding having coffee and rolls for sale as to go or to have while sitting during the sale-Donna will contact Sue Garrett. Sue was contacted regarding

committee providing rolls. Sue stated the Parish Life Committee is not interested in doing this at this time.

Silver Cord Hours-H-D school will be contacted to inform of event and see if the volunteer hours can be used for silver cord hours. Once gets closer to school opening, this will be addressed with the appropriate school staff.

Advertising- Information to Center 1 to be included in the garage sale promotion. Also, will see about advertising on the radio. Sue checking with Center 1 for process.

- ✓ *Location in church of sale* will be in the Social Hall at this time.
- ✓ *Contact other committee chairpersons* will be done in the near future. Donna will get chairpersons contacted when information available.

IV. Set monthly meeting day, time, place. Meetings will be held the 3rd Monday of the month at 6:30 pm in the RE kitchenette. If there is a linkage liturgy meeting the same night, this meeting will be held after.

V. Maggie will work on this after the Garage Sale is completed. More discussion will be held regarding this at a later date. May consider sending to college students also.
