25 de Agosto – La Misa del Sagrado Palio para el Arzobispo

August 25 – The Pallium Mass for the Archbishop

In Iowa, our Bishop is the Archbishop, making our diocese the Archdiocese.

An Archbishop is the Bishop who oversees and leads the other bishops in his region, or in the U.S.A., the other bishops of the state.

As a sign of this, the Archbishop has a special vestment called a “Pallium.” It is a strip of white woolen cloth that drapes on the shoulders of the Archbishop, symbolizing the lost sheep that the Good Shepherd goes out to find and carry on his shoulders. It is a reminder to the Archbishop and to the people that he, the Archbishop, is supposed to be a model and example of Christ the Good Shepherd, both for his fellow bishops and for all of us.

This Pallium is made in Rome. Every year, two lambs, which are raised by monks at the Monastery of Tre Fontane (where St. Paul was martyred), are brought to the Basilica at St. Agnes in Rome on the Feast of St. Agnes (Jan. 21) and are specially blessed by the Pope. Saint Agnes, who was a virgin martyr in Rome, has become associated with blessings of lambs, as her name means lamb. Benedictine nuns, who are at the Basilica of St. Cecilia in Rome, then care for these two specially blessed lambs. And just before Easter, wool is taken from these two lambs and used to make the Palliums for new Archbishops.

On June 29, the Feast of Sts. Peter and Paul, all new Archbishops throughout the world come and receive these special Palliums directly from the Pope.

Why do I share all this? On June 29, our own Archbishop Thomas Zinkula went to Rome and received his Pallium from Pope Francis. But, while Archbishop received the Pallium from the Pope, subsequently a special Mass will be celebrated in the Archbishop’s own Archdiocese, where the Apostolic Nuncio – the Pope’s representative to the United States – will formally vest the Archbishop with the new Pallium.

So, we will be celebrating this special “Pallium Mass” next week on Sunday, Sept. 8 at 2 p.m. at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, in Hiawatha, Ia., near Cedar Rapids. All are invited to come! Yes, that means you! You are invited to attend this special Mass with the Archbishop (and this would count for your Sunday Mass). There will be a special talk by the Apostolic Nuncio *before* the Mass at 1:15 p.m. as well. No need to RSVP, just show up!

If you are unable to attend, you can watch it online, as it will be live streamed. For more information visit

En Iowa, nuestro obispo es el arzobispo, haciendo de nuestra diócesis la arquidiócesis.

Un arzobispo es el obispo que supervisa y dirige a los demás obispos de su región o, en los EE. UU., a los demás obispos del estado.

Como signo de ello, el arzobispo tiene una vestimenta especial llamada el “Sagrado Palio”. Es una faja de lana blanca que cubre sus hombros, simbolizando la oveja perdida y el Buen Pastor que va a su encuentro y la acarrea en sus hombros. Es un recordatorio al arzobispo y al pueblo de que él, debe ser un modelo y ejemplo de Cristo el Buen Pastor, tanto para sus compañeros obispos como para todos nosotros.

El Palio es fabricado en Roma. Cada año, dos corderos criados por monjes del Monasterio de las Tres Fuentes (donde fue martirizado San Pablo), se llevan a la Basílica de Santa Inés en Roma en la Solemnidad de Santa Inés (el 21 de enero) y son bendecidos especialmente por el Papa. Santa Inés, quien fue una virgen mártir en Roma, se ha asociado con las bendiciones de los corderos, ya que su nombre significa cordero.

Las religiosas de Santa Cecilia en Roma cuidan de estos corderos especialmente bendecidos. Estos corderos se esquilan justo antes de la Pascua y su lana se usa para tejer los nuevos Palios para los nuevos arzobispos.

El 29 de junio, en la Solemnidad de los Santos Apóstoles Pedro y Pablo, todos los nuevos arzobispos del mundo reciben estos Palios directamente del mismo Papa.

¿Por qué comparto todo esto? El pasado 29 de junio, nuestro propio Arzobispo Thomas Zinkula recibió en Roma el Palio de manos del Papa Francisco. Mientras el Arzobispo recibió el Palio del Papa, posteriormente se celebrará una Misa especial en la propia arquidiócesis del arzobispo, donde el Nuncio Apostólico – el representante del Papa en los Estados Unidos – formalmente impondrá el Palio al arzobispo.

Así es que estaremos celebrando la Misa especial del Palio el próximo domingo 8 de septiembre a las 2 p.m. en Sta. Elizabeth Ann Seton, en Hiawatha, Ia., cerca de Cedar Rapids. ¡Todos están invitados. Si, tú! Estas invitado asistir a esta Misa especial con el arzobispo (que cuenta como Misa del domingo). Habrá también una charla especial con el Nuncio Apostólico *antes* de la Misa a las 1:15 p.m. No necesitas responder, ¡sólo asiste!

New Immigration Process for Noncitizen Spouses and Stepchildren of U.S. Citizens

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) announced on June 18, 2024, that it will be establishing a new process in an effort to promote family unity. This process will allow certain noncitizens who entered the United States without authorization to request to Parole in Place (PIP). If parole is granted, noncitizens will generally be able to apply for lawful permanent residence (green card) without having to depart or leave the United States, will be eligible for work authorization, and will be protected from deportation during the parole period. 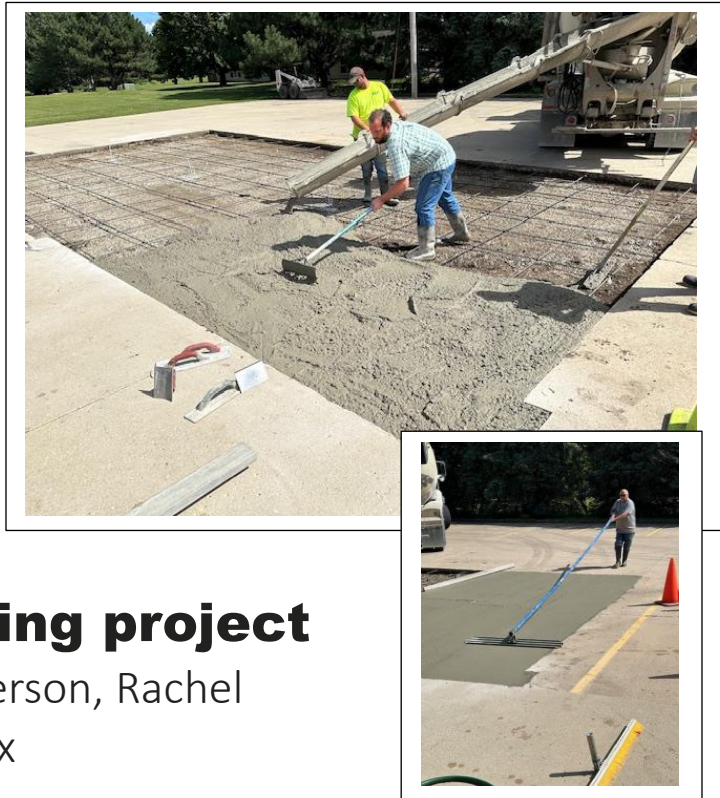
