# St. Mary St. Patrick

**31 de Marzo – ¡Feliz Pascua de Resurrección!**  
**¡Proclama el Evangelio!**

¡Feliz Pascua! ¡Cristo ha resucitado, Aleluya! ¡En verdad ha resucitado, Aleluya!  
¡Estamos llamados a proclamar el Evangelio! La Buena Nueva de la Salvación de Cristo ofrecida a nosotros pecadores a través de Su Cruz y Resurrección!  
Durante la Pascua regresan a la iglesia personas que no han venido hace mucho tiempo; es también un buen momento para invitarlos a seguir viniendo.  
De hecho, los distintos pastores del Condado de Franklin nos estamos uniendo para hacer un esfuerzo conjunto de alcance para ¡invitar a la gente a la iglesia! Especialmente a aquellos que quizá han estado alejados por mucho tiempo o quienes *escasamente o nunca* han estado en una iglesia.

Esto sucederá de varias maneras:

- 1) Estamos haciendo tarjetas con los horarios de los servicios religiosos de todas las iglesias del Condado de Franklin. *Aquí es donde te pediremos ayuda para compartirlas con otros, especialmente con ¡aquellos que quizás no vayan a ninguna iglesia!*
- 2) Como pastores, también estaremos publicando una serie de artículos en el periódico The Hampton Chronicle invitando a que la gente vaya a la iglesia, y respondiendo a la pregunta, “¿Por qué la Iglesia?”
- 3) El martes 16 de abril a las 6:30 p.m., estaremos realizando un “Panel del Pastor” en el Windsor Theater, para que la gente que asista le haga preguntas a los pastores del área. Por favor trata de asistir, e invita especialmente a personas que conozcas que quizás hayan estado alejados de la iglesia por algún tiempo.

Como católicos, esto coincide con nuestro año de Avivamiento Eucarístico. Parte del avivamiento eucarístico nacional incluye la iniciativa “Invita a que alguien vuelva”. Esto es para que nosotros: 1) Oremos intencionalmente por aquellos que han abandonado, o han estado alejados de la Iglesia por mucho tiempo; 2) Consideremos en oración a quién el Señor puede estar poniendo en nuestro corazón para que invitemos a regresar; 3) Oremos intencionalmente por esa persona y para que el Señor nos muestre cuándo y cómo invitarlo a regresar; 4) Luego, ¡invitarlo amable y compasivamente a regresar a la iglesia! 5) También, considera en oración cómo el Señor te está llamando a, quizá, seguir acompañando a esa persona durante su vida.

Oremos juntos plenamente como Dios nos está llamando a que cada uno proclame el Evangelio de una manera nueva, y a quién su Espíritu nos está guiando para invitarnos a regresar a la Iglesia y ¡a tener una relación más intencional con Cristo!

¡Proclama la Buena Nueva! ¡El Evangelio de Jesucristo! ¡Amén, Aleluya!

## **March 31 – Happy Easter! Proclaim the Gospel!**

Happy Easter! Christ is risen, Alleluia! He is risen indeed, Alleluia!  
We are called to proclaim the Gospel! The Good News of Christ’s Salvation offered to us sinners through His Cross and Resurrection!  
As Easter is also a time when people come to church that haven’t been for a long time, this is a great time to invite them to keep coming!  
In fact, the various pastors of Franklin County, we are coming together to do a united effort of outreach to invite people to church! Especially those who perhaps have been away for a long time or who have *rarely or never* been to church!

We are doing this in various ways:

- 1) We are making handout cards that have the times of church services of all the churches in Franklin County. *This is where we will also be asking your help to share them with others, especially those who might not be going to any church!*
- 2) As the pastors we will also have a series of articles in the Hampton Chronicle inviting people to church, and responding to the question, “Why Church”
- 3) On Tuesday, April 16 at 6:30 p.m., we will be having a “Pastor’s Panel” at the Windsor Theater for people to come and ask us area pastors questions! Please consider coming, and especially invite people you may know whom perhaps have been away from church for a while!

As Catholics, this coincides with our year of Eucharistic Revival. Part of the National Eucharistic Revival includes the “Invite One Back” Initiative. This is for us to: 1) pray intentionally for those who have left or been away from the Church for a long time; 2) Prayerfully consider whom the Lord may be placing on your heart to invite back; 3) Pray intentionally for that person and for the Lord to show you when and how to invite that person; 4) Then, kindly and compassionately invite them back to church! 5) Also, prayerfully consider how the Lord is calling you to perhaps continue accompanying that person in their lives.

Let us together prayerfully how God is calling us each personally to proclaim the Gospel in a new a way, and who His Spirit is guiding us to invite back to Church and into a more intentional relationship with Christ!

Proclaim the Good News! The Gospel of Jesus Christ! Amen! Alleluia!
