
"I am from a big farmer family in north Vietnam. My parents have ten children, I am the eighth. I have three older brothers, four older sisters (two of my sisters have passed away), two younger brothers. I grew up with a peaceful childhood in a Catholic family. My parents were very active members and leaders of the church in my village, so they raised their children in the way of their beliefs and according to what they thought was right therefore I grew up with a rich spiritual life. I went to the church in my village often with my parents and brothers, sister, usually in the evenings throughout the week to say a rosary or do Adoration. On the weekend, my parents brought us to the parish church to attend the Sunday Mass. As a part of my family tradition, on every big feast day in the liturgical calendar, my family had a party that helped us to rejoice and unite with the church. Raising us with these practices, my faith in God and the Catholic church gradually and naturally developed. In addition, the people in my village were all Catholic, and interestingly my home was in fact right next to the church. The yard of the church was the place where I hung out with my friends and that was also where I came to worship God and pray, so this is how the Church and the Catholic faith have become something very natural to me and became one of the most important parts of my childhood. When I was in eighth grade, the pastor of my parish encouraged me to become a priest. Before that, when he baptized me, he told my parents that "this boy will become a priest."

My dad was the leader of my village church. For almost 30 years, he has done so many things to build the church and the Catholic community in my village. I observed and in some ways I contributed to that process. These things with my dream about spreading the Gospel were my motivations in pursuing the priesthood."

We are grateful to have another brother priest to serve in the Archdiocese of Dubuque. Please also pray for more priestly vocations in our Archdiocese.

Father Hung Le

Ayer, sábado 24 de mayo, nuestra Arquidiócesis tuvo la alegría de ordenar a otro sacerdote, el P. Hung Le. Les pedimos que oren por él, ya que inicia su ministerio sacerdotal en la Arquidiócesis de Dubuque. Aquí les cuento un poco sobre él, en sus propias palabras:

"Vengo de una familia numerosa de agricultores del norte de Vietnam. Mis padres tienen diez hijos, yo soy el octavo. Tengo tres hermanos mayores, cuatro hermanas mayores (dos de ellas fallecieron) y dos hermanos menores. Crecí en una familia católica, con una infancia tranquila. Mis padres eran miembros muy activos y líderes de la iglesia de mi pueblo, así que criaron a sus hijos según sus creencias y según lo que consideraban correcto. Por lo tanto, crecí con una rica vida espiritual. Iba a menudo a la iglesia de mi pueblo con mis padres, hermanos y hermana, generalmente por las tardes de la semana para rezar el rosario o hacer la Adoración. Los fines de semana, mis padres nos llevaban a la parroquia para asistir a la misa dominical. Como parte de mi tradición familiar, en cada gran día festivo del calendario litúrgico, mi familia celebraba una fiesta que nos ayudaba a regocijarnos y unirnos a la iglesia. Al criarnos con estas prácticas, mi fe en Dios y en la Iglesia católica se desarrolló de forma gradual y natural. Además, la gente de mi pueblo... Soy católico, y curiosamente mi casa estaba justo al lado de la iglesia. El patio de la iglesia era el lugar donde me reunía con mis amigos y también donde iba a adorar a Dios y a orar. Así es como la Iglesia y la fe católica se han convertido en algo muy natural para mí y se han convertido en una parte importante de mi infancia. Cuando estaba en octavo grado, el párroco de mi parroquia me animó a ser

Cuando estaba en octavo grado, el parroco de mi parroquia me animo a ser sacerdote. Antes de eso, cuando me bautizó, les dijo a mis padres: "Este chico será sacerdote".

Mi padre era el líder de la iglesia de mi pueblo. Durante casi 30 años, ha hecho muchas cosas para construir la iglesia y la comunidad católica en mi pueblo. Observé y, de alguna manera, contribuí a ese proceso. Estas cosas, junto con mi sueño de difundir el Evangelio, fueron mis motivaciones para aspirar al sacerdocio.

Estamos agradecidos de tener otro hermano sacerdote para servir en la Arquidiócesis de Dubuque. Por favor, oren también por más vocaciones sacerdotales en nuestra Arquidiócesis.
