Oct. 20 – World Mission Sunday and Hurricane Relief

Last week I spoke that this Sunday, Oct. 20, is World Mission Sunday, a day where the Pope asks us to take a special collection to support the Church throughout the world by supporting the Pontifical Mission Societies. The Pontifical Mission Societies (TPMS) are a worldwide network at the service of the Pope that supports the missions and the Young Churches with prayer and charity.

As you may have heard, hurricanes Helene and Milton have caused major and widespread damage in the Southeastern United States. Thus, in keeping of the spirit of World Mission Sunday, we will still take up a special collection for the work of charity; however, this collection will be specifically for Hurricane relief in our country. We will do this through the charitable arm of the local Catholic Church, Catholic Charities USA.

Checks can be made out to parish for “Hurricane Relief” and then, we as the parish will write one large check to Catholic Charities.

Where will my donation go? Catholic Charities USA (CCUSA) distributes 100 percent of funds received directly to Catholic Charities agencies in disaster-stricken communities to care for our affected neighbors.

Why give to Catholic Charities USA? CCUSA is the official domestic relief agency of the Catholic Church in the United States. In addition to providing financial support directly to communities affected by natural disasters, CCUSA has a long history of assisting in the rapid mobilization of Catholic Charities agency staff across the U.S. In doing so, they not only meet the immediate needs, but they also provide critical, long-term support to communities as they rebuild.

As of Oct. 8, thanks to the generous support of donors to the Catholic Charities USA Hurricane Helene disaster relief fund, CCUSA has distributed \$1.9 million thus far to Catholic Charities agencies in Florida, Georgia, South Carolina, North Carolina, Virginia, and Tennessee. All 100 percent of the funds raised for Hurricane Helene relief are being distributed to local agencies assisting those displaced or suffering because of the storm.

20 de oct. – Domingo Mundial de las Misiones y ayuda para los afectados por los huracanes

La semana pasada dije que este domingo 20 de oct. es el Domingo Mundial de las Misiones, un día en el que el Papa nos pide realizar una colecta especial para apoyar a las iglesias de todo el mundo por medio de las Obras Misionales Pontificias. Las Sociedades de Misiones Pontificias (TPMS, por sus siglas en inglés) son una red mundial al servicio del Papa que apoya las misiones y a las Iglesias jóvenes con oración y caridad.

Como te habrás enterado, los huracanes Helene y Milton han dejado daños importantes y generalizados en el sureste de los Estados Unidos. Por lo tanto, manteniendo el espíritu del Domingo Mundial de las Misiones, continuaremos realizando una colecta especial para obras de caridad; en este caso, para ayudar específicamente a los damnificados de los huracanes en nuestro país. Esto, a través del brazo caritativo de la Iglesia Católica local, Caridades Católicas de los EE. UU.

Los cheques se pueden hacer a nombre de la parroquia para “Hurricane Relief” (en memo) y posteriormente, como parroquia haremos un cheque con el monto total a Caridades Católicas.

¿A dónde irá mi donación? Caridades Católicas de los EE. UU. (CCUSA, por sus siglas en inglés) distribuye el 100 por ciento de los fondos recaudados directamente a las agencias de Caridades Católicas en las comunidades afectadas por desastres para cuidar a nuestros vecinos afectados.

¿Por qué donar a Caridades Católicas de los EE. UU.? CCUSA es la agencia oficial de ayuda interna de la Iglesia Católica en los Estados Unidos. Además de brindar apoyo financiero directamente a las comunidades afectadas por desastres naturales, CCUSA tiene una larga trayectoria de asistencia en la rápida movilización del personal de las agencias de Caridades Católicas en todo Estados Unidos. Al hacerlo, no sólo satisfacen las necesidades inmediatas, sino que también brindan apoyo crítico y a largo plazo a las comunidades mientras se reconstruyen.

Desde el 8 de oct., gracias al generoso apoyo de los donantes al fondo de ayuda para el desastre del huracán Helene de Caridades Católicas de los EE. UU., CCUSA ha distribuido, hasta ahora, \$1.9 millones a agencias de Caridades Católicas en Florida, Georgia, Carolina del Sur, Carolina del Norte, Virginia, y Tennessee. El 100 por ciento de los fondos recaudados para ayudar a las víctimas del huracán Helene se están distribuyendo a las agencias locales que ayudan a los desplazados, o quienes sufren a causa de la tormenta.

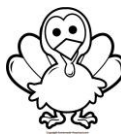
