P. Scott Bullock

September 22 – To Rapid City, South Dakota! Pray for Fr. Scott Bullock

After our evening Spanish Mass, I will be heading to Rapid City, S. Dak., to return Tuesday, Sept. 24, in time for a 6 p.m. talk that I will be giving about angels at the Rustic Brew in Hampton.

I am going to South Dakota because a priest of the Archdiocese of Dubuque, Fr. Scott Bullock, will be ordained as their new bishop. Fr. Scott Bullock was the Director of the College Seminary during my first two years of Seminary. Into my priesthood, he has continued to be a mentor and a friend. While I am very sad to lose him from the Archdiocese – as he is a good man, priest, mentor and friend – it gives me great hope and inspiration to know that men like him are called upon to be bishops. He will be a very good and holy bishop, and will shepherd the Church in Rapid City, S. Dak. in humility and holiness.

For his Episcopal Motto, he chose *Surgite eamus* (Rise, let us be on our way).

At a farewell dinner, he shared with us why he chose this motto. That these words are not just the general call to follow Christ, but Christ says these words to his disciples in the Garden of Gethsemane (see Mt. 26:46); the call to follow Christ even into the greatest suffering of his earthly life – the betrayal, the Cross, the Crucifixion and death. It is the trust to follow Christ not just when it is easy, but to wherever he calls, even when it is difficult. “Because,” Fr. Scott told us, “we trust that Christ will lead us even through suffering and death to life on the other side.”

On the Diocese of Rapid City website, he more formally explains about his motto:

“Christ is spurring onward His disciples into the fullness of life, which is only and ever found through the Paschal Mystery of Jesus’ death and resurrection. ‘Rise’ is the same verb used in the gospels to refer to Jesus’ healings as well as His resurrection. In this, Jesus definitively declares the divine will that we rise with Him, both through healings of body and soul in this life and in the resurrection in eternity ... Divine love impels Jesus forward towards our salvation and we, if we are willing, are drawn along His way into new life and will want to draw others into this new life. Jesus sets Himself with determination (and his disciples with Him) on the way of self-sacrificial love to the fullness of life that He has already promised, ‘I have come that they might have life, and have it in abundance’ (John 10:10). Let us be on our Christian way of immersing ourselves with Jesus through Mary in the saving cross and resurrection of our salvation. Full life is at hand. *Surgite eamus.*”

Después de nuestra misa vespertina en español, me dirigiré a Rapid City, Dakota del Sur, para regresar el martes 24 de septiembre, a tiempo para dar una charla sobre los ángeles a las 6 p.m. en Rustic Brew en Hampton.

Voy a Dakota del Sur porque un sacerdote de la Arquidiócesis de Dubuque, el padre Scott Bullock, será ordenado como su nuevo obispo.

El P. Scott Bullock fue el Director del Seminario Universitario durante mis dos primeros años de Seminario. Durante mi sacerdocio, ha continuado siendo un mentor y amigo. Si bien estoy muy triste por perderlo en la arquidiócesis – ya que es un buen hombre, sacerdote, mentor y amigo – me da gran esperanza e inspiración saber que hombres como él están llamados a ser obispos. Será un obispo muy bueno y santo, y pastoreará la Iglesia en Rapid City, Dakota del Sur, con humildad y santidad. Como lema episcopal eligió *Surgite eamus* (Levantaos, pongámonos en camino).

En una cena de despedida, nos contó por qué eligió este lema. Que estas palabras no son sólo un llamado general a seguir a Cristo, sino que Cristo dice estas palabras a sus discípulos en el Huerto de Getsemaní (ve Mt. 26:46); el llamado a seguir a Cristo incluso en el mayor sufrimiento de su vida terrena: la traición, la cruz, la crucifixión y la muerte. Es la confianza de seguir a Cristo no sólo cuando es fácil, sino donde sea que Él nos llame, incluso cuando es difícil. “Porque,” el P. Scott nos dijo, “confiamos en que Cristo nos conducirá, incluso a través del sufrimiento y la muerte, a la vida al otro lado.”

En el sitio web de la Diócesis de Rapid City, explica más formalmente su lema:

“Cristo está impulsando a sus discípulos hacia la plenitud de la vida, que sólo se encuentra y siempre se encuentra a través del misterio pascual de la muerte y resurrección de Jesús. ‘Levantarse’ es el mismo verbo utilizado en los evangelios para referirse a las curaciones de Jesús, así como a su resurrección. En esto, Jesús declara definitivamente la voluntad divina de que resucitemos con Él, tanto a través de las curaciones del cuerpo y del alma en esta vida como en la resurrección en la eternidad ... El amor divino impulsa a Jesús hacia nuestra salvación y nosotros, si estamos dispuestos, somos arrastrados por su camino hacia una nueva vida y querremos atraer a otros a esta nueva vida. Jesús se pone con determinación (y sus discípulos con Él) en el camino del amor abnegado hacia la plenitud de vida que Él ya ha prometido, ‘Yo he venido para que tengan vida, y para que la tengan en abundancia’ (Juan 10:10). Sigamos nuestro camino cristiano de sumergirnos con Jesús a través de María en la cruz salvadora y resurrección de nuestra salvación. La vida plena está a la mano. *Surgite eamus.*”
