SOME "LITURGICAL" (TEMPLE) NOTES

- Heavenly Temple (Which looks a lot like Jerusalem Temple) continues to be command center from which judgement on world takes place
 - This is where FAMILIARITY with Temple in back of mind is helpful (why we watched video a couple of weeks ago)
- "Altar of Incense" (Rev. 8:5)
- "Four Horns" of Altar (Rev. 9:13)
- Outer and inner courts of Temple Rev. 11:1-2
- Holy of Holies/Ark of the Covenant (Rev. 11:19)
 Remember, Tearing of Temple Veil at Jesus' Sacrifice



WORD ABOUT JUDGMENT AND WRATH

- Left to consequences of own sin
- Exposing of truth...in a way BEASTS in Revelation are MORE REAL and MORE TRUE
- Allows for possibility of repentance and conversion



CENSER

- "Smoke of incense" = "Prayers of the Saints/Faithful"
- Cast coals of Censer upon the earth
- 4 trumpets involve FIERY thing FALLING FROM SKY (HEAVEN)

SEVEN TRUMPETS

1 – **Earth** Grass and Trees Burned

• Hail (Fire & Blood)

2 – **Sea:** turns to blood; ships destroyed

Burning Mountain

3 – Waters: turn bitter

• Star (Wormwood)

4 – **Sky:** Sun and Moon and stars do not shine

5 – Locusts (with military power) – **TORMENT people** • Star

6 – 200 million man army; Third of mankind killed; 7 –Kingdom of God declared


1/3 of sun, moon, and stars donot shine. Rev. 8:12

CHALICE Judgments in Revelation	TRUMPET Judgments in Revelation	PLAGUES ON EGYPT In the book of Exodus
1 st Chalice: Poured out on the Land; people disfigured with sores (16:1-2)	1 st Trumpet: On the Land; 1/3 earth, trees, grass burned (8:7)	Boils (6 th plague: Exodus 9:8-12)
2 nd Chalice: Poured out on the sea, becoming blood (16:3)	2 nd Trumpet: On the sea; 1/3 of sea becomes blood, 1/3 sea creatures die, 1/3 ships destroyed (8:8-9)	Waters become blood (1 st plague: Exodus 7:17-21)
3 rd Chalice: Poured out on rivers and springs, becoming blood (16:8-9)	3 rd Trumpet: On rivers and springs;1/3 of waters become wormwood (8:10-11)	Waters become blood (1 st plague: Exodus 7:17-21)
4 th Chalice: Poured out on the sun, causing it to scorch = darkened (16:8-9)	4 th Trumpet: 1/3 of sun, moon, & stars darkened (8:12)	Darkness (9 th plague: Exodus 10:21-23)
5 th Chalice: Poured out on the throne of the Beast = darkness, pain and sores torment people (16:10-11)	5 th Trumpet: Demonic locusts tormenting mankind (9:13-21)	Locusts (8 th plague: Exodus 10: 4-20)
6 th Chalice: Poured out on the river [Euphrates], drying it up to make way for kings of the east; invasion of frog-demons; Armageddon (16:12-16)	6 th Trumpet: Invasion of army from the river [Euphrates] kills 1/3 of mankind (9:13-21)	Invasion of frogs from the river [Nile] (2 nd plague: Exodus 8:2-4)
7 th Chalice: Poured out on the air causing storm, earthquake, hail & the Great City splits	7 th Trumpet: Voices, storm, earthquake, hail (11:15-19)	Hail storm (7 th plague: Exodus 9:18-26)

SCARY LOCUSTS

- Terrifying power of Evil
- Crowns of Gold = Conquerors
- Human Faces = Intelligence
- Hairiness and Teeth = Ferocity (like Lions)
- Iron Breastplates = Warriors
- Noise and Scorpion Tales = Cruelty

Abbadon = "Destruction" or "Ruin" (Hebrew/Aramaic)

Apollyon = "Destroyer" (Greek)



EATING OF THE SCROLL

Revelation 10:8-10

"'Go, take the scroll that lies open in the hand of the angel....So I went up to the angel and told him to give me the small scroll. He said to me, 'Take and swallow it. It will turn your stomach sour, but in your mouth it will taste sweet as honey.' I took the small scroll from the angel's hand and swallowed it. In my mouth it was like sweet honey, but when I had eaten it, my stomach turned sour."

Ezekiel 2:9-10; 3:1-3

"It was then I saw a hand outstretched toward me, in which was a written scroll which he unrolled before me. It was covered with writing front and back, and written on it was: Lamentation and waling, and woe! He said to me: Son of man, eat what is before you; eat this scroll, then go, speak to the house of Israel. So I opened my mouth and he gave me the scroll to eat. Son of man, he then said to me, feed your belly and fill your stomach with this scroll I am giving you. I ate it, and it was as sweet as honey in my mouth..."

EATING OF THE SCROLL

Revelation 10:8-10

- JEREMIAH and EZEKIEL
- BOTH in relationship to BABYLON (important symbol in Revelation)

Context of EXILE

- Jeremiah (on VERGE of being conquered/Exiled)
- Ezekiel currently IN Babylon IN Exile



"1260 DAYS"

Reference to Persecution by Antiochus Epiphanes IV During MACCABEES (1 Mc. 1:33; 1:54) See Daniel 7:25; 12:7

- **42 months** (Rev. 11:2)
- 42 / 12 = 3.5 years (Rev. 11:11 ... 3.5 "days")
 Half of 7
- •42 x 30 = **1260 Days**

(Rev. 11:3 ... also Rev. 12:6, with the Woman NEXT week)

- Deuteronomy 19:15
- John 8:17
- 2 Cor. 13:1-2





TWO WITNESSES SYMBOLISM OF TWO

- Two Lampstands
 - Rev. 11:4
- Lampstands
 Symbolic of
 Churches
 - Rev. 1:20
 - Seven Lampstands
 = Seven Churches
- Witness of Universal Church to the world

Persecuted Church



TWO WITNESSES

Moses – The Law

Turned water into blood

- (Exodus 7:14-16) (Rev. 11:6)
- Fire upon enemies
 - (Numbers 16:35)

Elijah – The Prophets

- Caused drought
 - (1 Kings 17:1-3; 18:1) (Rev. 11:6)
- Fire upon enemies
 - (2 Kings 1:10)





TWO WITNESSES

Transfiguration of Christ

Moses – The Law Elijah – The Prophets Spoke "of His exodus he was going to accomplish in Jerusalem"

-Luke 9:30-31

NOTE

- Temple (Rev. 11:1-2)
 - Jeursalem (Rev. 11:8)
