MERRY CHRISTMAS and Happy New Year!! I pray you each are having a blessed Christmas season! (Remember that for Catholics, Christmas does not end until Epiphany which we will celebrate this Sunday.) While the break was nice, I am ready for us to begin having gatherings again next week.

Since many of us may be struggling to get our brains out of "holiday/vacation" mode, I wanted to start with a few reminders...

1) Mass Time Changes begin this weekend. The new schedule is:

Saturday 4:00pm – St. Mary, Ackley

Saturday 6:30pm - St. Mary, Eldora

Sunday 8:00am – St. Mary, Hampton

Sunday 10:30am – St. Mark, Iowa Falls

Sunday 5:30pm – St. Patrick, Hampton (Spanish)

- 2) We will be continuing to meet virtually for Faith Formation for the time being. The Faith Formation Commission will meet again in February to re-evaluate. The attached calendar shows the schedule for the remainder of the year, showing options for both virtual and gathered sessions.
- 3) Classes resume for students in Kindergarten Grade 3 on January 6, Grades 4-8 on January 13, and Grades 9-10 on January 10.
- 4) If you haven't already, you can pick up your family's next sets of *Gospel Weeklies*. They are in a basket in the chapel entrance. Please feel free to stop and pick up the packet for your family. We will also have a pick-up night on January 5 (5:30-7:00pm). Pull up to the front of the church as we have done in the past.
- 5) *Epiphany Blessing:* This is a beautiful tradition of our faith. If you would like to bless your home this year I have attached the blessing to this email.

Kindergarten – Grade 3:

- Continue to do weekly home lessons using the Pflaum Gospel Weeklies that you will pick up. These should take about 20 minutes per week.
- Please be sure to have your student prepared for monthly virtual sessions (they should have their prayer book and Bible with them) and connected prior to 6:30pm. They should not be eating or drinking during the sessions. Contact me for connection information.
- Once a month we hold virtual family activities. All students and at least one parent is expected to attend these events. In January we will meet on January 20.
- We encourage you to check out the Wanderlight game if you have not done so yet. (Links were sent out, but let me know if you need the information again.) As administrator I can see how students are progressing, so if you ever have any questions, let me know.

Grades 4-5:

- Continue to do weekly home lessons using the Pflaum Gospel Weeklies that you picked up. These should take about 20 minutes per week.
- Please be sure to have your student prepared for monthly virtual sessions (they should have their prayer book and Bible with them) and connected prior to 6:30pm. They should not be eating or drinking during the sessions. Contact me for connection information.
